1. Approval of Prior Minutes

a. 12/9 minutes were voted on via email.

2. Reports

- a. Registrar's Report (Jeffry)
 - i. See attached form
 - ii. Lot of growth over two years.
 - iii. Likely to rise to 13-14% growth over last year by end of season.
 - iv. More variation in geography of members one of the reasons for growth.
- b. NERVA Report (Dave)
 - i. Juniors has run 9 weekends in a row, has been a challenge especially with a young player passing away after the Boston tournament.
 - ii. Had to shut off registration for Liberty Challenge due to being full with a waitlist.
 - iii. Are at about 16,000 members for the year.
 - iv. Dave is serving on a committee to discuss possible USAV changes.
 - v. Ideally adults December tournament will be back at Mohegan Sun in 2026 (2025 will be in Providence).
 - vi. Boston tournaments are being looked at for qualifier status which would likely add 600 teams overnight. If granted qualifier status adults would likely be out altogether for Boston convention center tournaments.
 - vii. Mohegan Sun is likely the best convention center option for adults because they are willing to not have a hotel room requirement if scheduled the same weekend as a concert.
 - viii. USAV is pushing to get into the grass volleyball world with a higher presence.
- c. Ratings Report (Jeffry)
 - i. Coverage is pretty solid, need more Women's and lower level coverage in Maine especially.
- d. Social Media Report (Amy)
 - i. See Attached figures from Amy
- e. Web Editor Report (Jeffry)
 - i. Site is currently working having had a couple of outages. Will continue to get slower.
 - ii. Getting ready to go to bid for custom site build.
- f. GrassRoots Campaign Report (Jeffry)
 - i. See attached for Scramble statistics.
 - Added a scramble for Liberty Challenge, hoping to have certified officials for those courts.
 - iii. 15% of new members this year have joined at scrambles.
- g. Tournament Director's Report (Mark)
 - i. Uptick in registrations for Champs, most are near full. Will push to get women's B/BB/A teams confirmed so that division can run.
 - ii. For Liberty Challenge no entry without QR code, will be a \$10 fee to get QR Code the day of.

3. New Business

- a. Planning
 - i. Liberty Challenge
 - 1. Trying to get certified officials for all Yankee Champs tournaments at Liberty Challenge, will likely need to do court managers for other tournaments.
 - 2. Judy is getting prizes for Liberty Challenge, Yankee Champs and Nationals gifts.
 - ii. Yankee Champs tournaments

- 1. Should have full coverage with certified officials for Champs at Taunton.
- iii. USAV Nationals
 - 1. Over 50 New England teams, a big jump from last two years.
 - 2. Judy is checking all rosters to verify memberships.
- iv. Yankee Picnic
 - 1. Wootown nets have not been returned in good shape the last few years (items missing from bag or poorly packed) so Yankee has agreed to rent the nets this year and pay for missing items so will be sure we check bags as packing up. Jeffry has 11 nets and Dave 10. Need 33-34 total.
 - 2. Jeffry, Mark, Geoff, Melissa, Amy and Miriam should be at picnic, others are unsure. Judy will have just had surgery so may not make it. Crystal Tasca and Corrinne Archibald have volunteered to assist also whether they know that or not yet.
 - 3. Sign-ups will open April 15th.
- b. Communication and transparency proposal (Amy) review
 - i. Tabled for further review and discussion.
- c. Ratings Guide (Geoff/Amy)
 - i. Sending electronically again so all board members can further review and give feedback.
 - ii. Would like to get this up on the website.
- d. Various Rules/Policy Discussions & Proposals
 - i. Flat tournament limits (Jeffry/Geoff)
 - 1. Tabled to look at more the idea of not allowing +2 players in flat (+0) tournaments, may be worth looking at how common it is.
 - ii. Email from member regarding team disqualifications
 - Was reviewed and determined that the policy we have in place is still the most fair for all involved members.
 - iii. Separate ratings for gender and RCO (Geoff?)
 - 1. Non Starter until we have a laid out plan for the new website.
 - iv. Emergency procedures at tournaments (Melissa)
 - 1. Tournament Directors should be educated on the emergency protocols of each venue.
 - 2. Judy will take over communicating the guidelines for emergency readiness to tournament directors.
 - v. Keeping brand new players re-ratable for a certain number of tournaments to help prevent "sandbagging" and therefore teams able to be DQd for getting players playing a first tournament out of position to be rated as a lower player and then play in a subsequent tournament as a higher player (Steve)
 - Discussed and determined this is not a big enough issue to inconvenience a larger amount of members who are doing nothing nefarious.
 - vi. Possible elimination of play-ins (Mark)
 - 1. Mark will study more but this is likely needed for the convention center tournaments which may be able to be achieved by running Juniors style with a championship and consolation bracket.
- e. Elections
 - i. Three spots are up for election (Treasurer and two at-large positions currently held by Nick and Melissa)
 - ii. Miriam will lead the Nominating Committee with Judy and Steve also serving on it)
 - iii. Mark will send out the mileage spreadsheet for board members to fill out)






Giving Back to Community – hoping to go live this year
